


### SPICE TOUR

Our guided walking tour passes through villages and spice plantations, a walk through the farms as spice farm workers climb trees, seek out specific plants and cut off various barks, to let you see, feel and taste it all. You will be decorated with palm-leaf accessories and have the opportunity to taste some of the exotic fruits of Zanzibar.





### STONE TOWN TOUR

Stone Town is the historic centre and cultural heart of Zanzibar. Very little changed in this town in the last 200 years. It is a place of winding alleys, bustling bazaars, mosques and grand Arab houses. With visits to the Cathedral, the former slave market for East African Slave trade and the Arab Fort amongst others, it is a fascinating look at the essence of Stone Town. There are some excellent gift shops with plenty of souvenirs and handcrafts to choose from.

Please respect the Muslim culture on Zanzibar and get dressed appropriately (try to cover shoulders and knees and please do not wear short skirts or pants). Don't forget to bring sunscreen, a hat or scarf and comfortable shoes.





### PRISON ISLAND TOUR

A traditional wooden Dhow will take you to Prison Island on a 20 minute ride from Stone Town. The island was formerly used as a private detention for disobedient slaves. Later a jail was constructed, but never actually used. Today the island is a small tourist resort, famous for its' giant tortoise sanctuary. Our tour guide will give you an introduction to the island's interesting past and you can then spend some time sunbathing, swimming, snorkeling or walking around to see tortoises and peacocks.

Please bring sunscreen, bikini or swimming shorts, hat or scarf, clothes for changing and waterproof shoes, such as reef shoes available in the hotel.







### JOZANI FOREST TOUR

Jozani forest is one of the last remaining sanctuaries of the red colubus monkey. The forest is 2,512 hectares in size and was declared a nature reserve in the 1960's. The monkeys are wild, but it is possible to get close to them while they carry on with their normal activities. A walk through this impressive flora and fauna is one of the highlights Zanzibar has to offer. At Jozani, you will also visit the Mangrove Swamp and walk around the Mangrove forest.





### SAFARI BLUE

A full day excursion on a traditional sailing Dhow. After sailing in the middle of the turquoise Indian Ocean accompanied by fresh drinks and snacks, the anchor is dropped at the Pungume sandbank, where sunshades are set up and you will have the chance to swim in the crystal-clear blue water and snorkel around the coral reefs, helped by our team. Around lunch time a table will be set up on the sandbank where you'll be able to enjoy a BBQ buffet.

Before sailing back to Kizimkazi, the boat will pass by the mangrove forest, where you might spot some monkeys and other animals. This tour is perfect for a big family excursion or romantic getaway. Karibu on board with us!

Note that this tour is available only depending on the wind and tide of the day, minimum 5 pax. You find more Information about this tour in our tours brochure.





### CAPTAIN SALUMS' SNORKELING TOUR WITH NGALAWA

Sail out with our captain to the beautiful reef spots around Jambiani. Discover the white sandy beaches with the Ngalawa – a canoe with double outriggers used by local fisherman famous for its amazing way of sailing and wind control. Captain Salum will show you all his secret snorkeling spots, so you will be able to explore the turquoise blue water full of tropical fish, reefs and starfish - Jambiani is a special area for Starfish, in fact you may see them in different colors and shapes. Simply enjoy the wonders of the Indian Ocean, while we'll provide you with all the professional snorkeling gear you might need for your amazing adventure.

Please note that the snorkeling tour is tide-dependent, so it will always be necessary to check for high and low tide before booking.





### BLUE LAGOON SNORKELING TOUR WITH CAPTAIN SALUM

The archipelago of Zanzibar offers some of the best snorkeling spots in the world with turquoise, warm, calm waters, great visibility and beautiful reefs. Our snorkeling tour allows you to explore these shallow coral gardens and crystal clear water starting from Pingwe, the north-western tip of the east coast, just 15 minutes away from our hotel; there you will take a speed boat with our Captain Salum – who is always available for any questions you might have about the beautiful coastline of Zanzibar. After you started to sail, you will have the chance to jump straight from the boat into the stunning turquoise water. As you sail back to the shore, we guarantee blissful relaxation while enjoying water and a good variety of local fruits on board.

Snorkeling equipment will be provided and please note that the snorkeling tour is tidedependent, so it will always be necessary to check for high and low tide before booking.







# LOCAL COMMUNITY TOURS

Don't miss Jambiani's famous Kuza Cave! You will receive a guided tour from one of the village's elders and experience this ancient, secret cave in the middle of Jambiani. Jump into the cave's pool and refresh yourself. Witness local drummers and dancers as you take in this local culture. Note bring your swimming clothes, a towel and proper shoes.

#### SEAWEED CENTRE

First stop is the seaweed centre in Paje, where you will get a glimpse of the traditional seaweed farming by local women in the area during low tide. As they take you out the reef you will observe the first step of producing organic cosmetics. Later you will join the "Seaweed Mamas" in the production hall, where you can witness the making of local soaps and oils. Feel free to bring some back for your friends as souvenirs! *Please note that this tour is only possible during low tide. Wear sunscreen and/or bring a hat!* 

#### VILLAGE TOUR

Follow us and get an authentic view of the local life! You will be introduced to the village of Jambiani, where you'll meet the director of the primary and secondary school. You'll be shown around the school and have the chance to contribute with a donation. Next, you will take a walk through the village taking in all historical and cultural spots. To round off the tour, you will meet the local healer, who will depict healing methods using regionally sourced ingredients and explain the uses of available fruits and spices.



### CATAMARAN SAILING

The Zanzibar archipelago features some of the Indian Ocean's most fascinating & beautiful islands. What a better way to explore these charming spots than from a catamaran while sailing through the turquoise and crystal-clear waters of Jambiani beach!

Our catamaran is operated by the experienced Captain Salum, who will offer fantastic trips all the way out to the reef and will also let you be an active crewmember with an introduction of the basic skills of sailing. Cruising on a catamaran is ideal if you want to get closer to the best shallow reefs for snorkeling & diving, so this is a great way to get out and explore the real beauty of Zanzibar for a couple of hours; this Archipelago is famous for its beautiful white sandy beaches, so don't miss the opportunity to explore these fascinating spots along the Indian Ocean coastline!





## WINDSURFING

Our watersport center offers the opportunity to enjoy this windsurf experience in front of our hotel with safe onshore wind & flat water, that offers perfect conditions for your adventure. An ideal spot to make you fall in love with the Zanzibar Archipelago. Whatever your level is, you will love windsurfing in Jambiani's warm waters with wind that never stops to blow.

The spot is ideal for beginners and free-riders; the first one can ask for lessons (for more information ask at our reception), while the more experienced ones can rent our equipment; in fact, our watersport center offers all the necessary gear, such as a harness, boards of different volumes (125 |, 160 |, 175 |), and sails in different sizes (4, 4.2, 6.5).

So, get ready to start your windsurfing holiday with us!





### STAND UP PADDLING

Start your day early in the morning with a refreshing paddling session and welcome the sun & the new day standing on your SUP board watching as the sunrise reflects in the warm water of Zanzibar. Stand-up paddling is a unique adventure and a fantastic way to explore the natural area, experience a tropical adventure, and it is also a chance to see jumping fish & other marine life around you. We will make your SUP experience as easy and enjoyable as possible, even If you are a beginner. First you will be able to familiarize yourself with the paddling and the basic techniques, and once you feel confident, our Captain Salum will go with you into the water, and paddle around for a while in the kneeling position (called safe position) until you are comfortable with turning and generally being on board. Then, you will be able to get into the stand-up position and paddle around the shore of Jambiani beach and around the Jetty – our pier along the Indian Ocean.

Please note that this session is tide-dependent, so make sure to book your SUP the day before.





# TUBING, WAKE BOARD, WATER SKI

With the hot sun and the blue skies of Jambiani, here you will find the perfect location to try tubing, wake boarding or water skiing. Our watersport center is well equipped with a speedboat that produces the perfect ride, flexible for all levels of experience, so you are free to choose if you prefer to test your balance and surfing skills as you are pulled through the water or just relax and go for a ride on your tube. Our waterskiing and wake boarding equipment is suitable for both beginners or non, and our experienced Captain Salum will be available to give you some pointers to improve your skills, show you new tricks and new cool moves. If you prefer to enjoy your time tubing on the turquoise water of the Zanzibar Archipelago, our large inflatable tube is pulled behind the speedboat and bounces across the water while you try to hold on; fast turns, big jumping and bumping into the waves can be the definition of excitement! All the activities will start just right in front of the Jetty, our pier along the Indian Ocean.





### **KITESURF**

if you've come to Zanzibar and still want to be active on your holiday, this is the sport for you! The East-Coast especially is the ideal spot for Kitesurfing, just take your board out and surf around the Spice Island Jetty.

For beginners we arrange as many lessons as you want. You will start by mastering the basics of riding and staying upwind, and can then start going faster, doing freestyle kicks and even riding waves.
